**Candy Bars** - Nicole Miller reported that 808 Candy Bars have been sold since the report last meeting (1/20 till 2/17). \$1,089 collected/turned in tonight. Grand total for Candy Bars sold is 4,082 (\$4,390.50) since this fall. Sales have been down since last month, but with the snow the last two weekends, we'll hopefully see an increase. The candy bars are a still a good deal at \$2 each, proceeds help support the club.

**Trails**: Matt recognized our new Groomer Dan Flanagan and all the others that have been grooming since we got snow the first week of February. A lot of hours have been logged so far - averaging 16 hrs/day.

The club will submit an application to Susie Tollander (county) to submit the the state to make trails 21, 22, 23 & 24 funded trails.

Bob Pace is still working on signs. He's looking at a full upgrade of the menu boards to update them and make them more uniform; this project would be worked on over the summer/fall.

The trail for the groomer drivers to use between the club barn south to the trail at Lake 26 road and Hwy 35 is not a valid/legal trail to use. Groomer drivers will need to take the long way into Danbury (via trail from Salty Steer). Reservation Police are patrolling and ticketing snowmobilers using this unofficial trail to get from Danbury to the Salty Steer.
